## Hotel Information

## District Assessment

The district assessment amount will remain at \$.66 per congregation member, the same as it was in 2022. Each district will receive an invoice from our office in January. A few newer district executives may not be aware of the history of the district assessment which began over a hundred years ago, in 1907. Years ago, the Historical Archives researched Annual Conference Minutes and other documents to find out the assessment for each year. There were years when they couldn’t find the exact number, but they

filled in as much as they have records for. That document is attached if you are interested in that history. The “every member” assessment was initiated because Annual Conference belongs to the whole church—not simply the people who attend Annual Conference and pay a registration fee.
